

NOTICE TO COMMITS OFFERORS

Based on the recommendation of GAO, the Government will afford all technically acceptable offerors the opportunity to make an oral presentation. In order to determine which offerors are technically acceptable, the Government must use price in making this decision. **While we are required to evaluate price in making this decision, the evaluation criteria have not changed.**

To facilitate this decision, the Government has developed labor category descriptions for each functional area. In order to ensure an accurate comparison of the labor categories between those presented by offerors and the government, we will soon request clarification of your proposed labor categories. **This will not be a request for revised pricing or a request for revised technical or price proposals. Further, the Government will not be soliciting nor will we accept any revisions to your proposal. Specifically, the Government will not accept revisions to: (1) Quality Recognitions and Certifications; (2) Past Performance Management; (3) Team Composition; and (4) Price.**

After our re-evaluation of proposals to determine which offerors are technically acceptable, the Government will contact you to schedule an oral presentation. (See Section L.8., Instructions for Oral Presentation). At this point, you will have the option to come in for an oral presentation or voluntarily remove yourself from consideration. (See Section M.1 of the solicitation.) We anticipate oral presentations to begin on or about May 1, 2000.
